a) Data reviewed:

- (1) Evidence of Planning Rubric, Fall, 2010
- (2) Evidence of Unit Planning Rubric, Spring 2011

b) Scope of data and adequacy of data addressed:

- (1) Evidence of planning rubric was used on Lessons in Fall 2010, but changed in Spring 2011 to more accurately describe what candidates were doing in their unit planning.
- (2) The resulting final rubric is highly adequate as it currently stands.
- (3) In Fall, 2010, 47 candidates were evaluated on Evidence of Planning (Lessons).
- (4) In Spring, 2011, 21 candidates were evaluated on Evidence of Planning (Unit of Study).

c) Generalizations and inferences from the data presented:

- (1) Prior to Fall, 2010, Evidence of Planning was collected in a Unit of Study developed in a course called ECH 3350
- (2) With a change in faculty, ECH 3350 became a focus course of lesson planning, and ECH 4350 became the focus course for unit of study planning.

d) Issues identified are addressed

Candidates were overall more proficient, as measured by the rubric, at planning at the lesson level.

e) Plan of action to correct deficiencies presented with benchmark timelines

(1) Fall, 2011, the decision to measure evidence of planning using the sets of lessons created for ECH 3350 was confirmed due to overall value in measuring candidate growth in the area.

(2) Spring 2012, lesson planning rubric will be set up in TaskStream with the help of Dr. Eisenwine. Dr. Maxedon will meet with her starting Dec. 9, 2011. A DRF will be set up for submitting and scoring lessons planned in ECH 3350.
