& **DIAL 911**

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ALL EMERGENCIES

- Report all campus emergencies to University Police (UPD) at 325-942-2071.
- Call 9-1-1 to request Fire Department or Emergency Medical Services, if needed.
- Suspend classes and events in the affected area for the duration of the emergency.
- Follow instructions from emergency personnel, ASUAlert, and campus officials.
- Avoid the affected area until an "All Clear" is issued by emergency personnel.
- Whenever possible, assist persons with special needs.
