GUIDELINES FOR TRANSFER REQUEST

Students requesting to transfer to Angelo State University's Generic Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree program from another Generic B.S.N.-level nursing program must submit the following information:

1. A letter requesting to be considered for transfer admission – stating the reasons for this transfer AND a completed application to the GBSN program.
2. Transcripts from all colleges/universities attended.
3. Syllabi of nursing courses completed.
4. Examples/copies of course work.
5. Letter of good standing from the director of the nursing program.
6. Letter of reference from at least one clinical instructor.

Students must meet admission/progression requirements of ASU Nursing Program, including:

- a. Cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or higher
- b. Grade of "C" or better in all math, science, and nursing prerequisites and nursing program courses
- c. TEAS V Nursing Entrance Exam

Students must meet admission requirements of ASU Admissions Office.

Potential credit for nursing courses can only be considered for two years.

All materials above must be received a minimum of two months prior to application deadline in order for materials to be reviewed.

The Nursing Department Admissions & Progressions Committee will review material submitted and make recommendations.

Students must complete 30 hours in residence to meet ASU graduation requirements.
