- The Foreign Language Festival Scholarship is a merit-based scholarship. Incoming freshmen who plan to major in a foreign language are eligible to apply. Transfer students with documented coursework in a foreign language who plan to major in this language and ASU foreign language majors are also eligible to apply.
- Incoming foreign language freshmen will be judged based on their ACT/SAT scores. They should have a minimum ACT score of 21 or an Old SAT score of 980-1010 New SAT score of 1060-1090.
- Continuing foreign language majors (transfer and ASU students) will be judged based on their GPAs. Their overall GPA should be 3.00 or higher, and no course grade in the major should be lower than a B.
- Preference will be given to students who have participated in or worked at ASU's Foreign Language Festival.
- If the number of eligible candidates exceeds the number of scholarships available, then priority will be given to the most qualified applicants.
- Awards (\$750.00) will be granted for the full academic year, with one half of the award being granted at the beginning of the fall semester and the second half of the award being granted at the beginning of the spring semester, provided the recipient has demonstrated satisfactory progress. **Application Deadline: June 1.**
