Angelo State University offers three music degrees:

- Bachelor of Arts in Music
- Bachelor of Music with a specialization in Teacher Certification
- Bachelor of Music with a specialization in Applied Performance

Audition pieces are from the Texas UIL Prescribed Music List (PML). The PML can be found at: http://wwwdev.uiltexas.org/pml/.

There are many compositions that are appropriate to use for the audition that are not on the PML. If there is a composition you would like to audition with that is not on the UIL PML, contact the audition chair prior to your audition to get the work approved by the faculty.

Voice

Bachelor of Arts and Music Minor

- One song, memorized, from the Texas UIL PML, any grade
- Sight reading

Bachelor of Music, Teacher Certification

- Two songs, memorized, from the Texas UIL PML, one from any grade, one from grade two or higher
- Sight reading

Bachelor of Music, Performance

- Two songs, memorized, from the Texas UIL PML, one from any grade, one from grade one. One must be in English and one in another language
- Sight reading

Piano

Bachelor of Arts and Music Minor

- One composition, memorized, from the current Texas UIL PML, any grade.
- White key major scales
 - o hands together
 - o one octave
 - o tempo of $\downarrow = 90$ beats per minute played in eighth-notes
- Sight reading

Bachelor of Music, Teacher Certification

- Two contrasting compositions, memorized, from the current Texas UIL PML, one from any grade, one from grade two or higher.
- White key major and minor scales
 - o hands together
 - o two octaves
 - o tempo of J = 108 beats per minute played in eighth-notes
- Sight reading

Strings

Bachelor of Arts and Music Minor

- Violin, viola, cello and double bass
 - o One composition from the current Texas UIL PML, any grade
 - o One or two octave scales
 - o Sight reading.

Bachelor of Music, Teacher Certification

- Violin, viola, cello and double bass
 - Two contrasting compositions from the current Texas UIL PML, one from any grade, one from grade two or higher
 - o Scales:
 - Violin, viola and cello: two or three octave scale of the auditioner's choice
 - Double bass: one or two octave scale of the auditioner's choice
 - o Sight reading

Bachelor of Music, Performance

- Violin, viola, cello and double bass
 - Two contrasting compositions from the current Texas UIL PML, one from grade one, one from grade two or higher
 - o Two or three octave scale of the auditioner's choice and its major/minor arpeggios
 - Sight reading

Woodwinds

Bachelor of Arts and Music Minor

- One composition from the Texas UIL PML, any grade, or the All-Region audition material.
- Major scales
- Chromatic scale
- Sight reading

Bachelor of Music, Teacher Certification

- Two contrasting compositions from the Texas UIL PML, one from any grade, one from grade two or higher, or one solo grade two or higher and one All-Region etude of contrasting styles.
- Major scales
- Chromatic scale
- Sight reading

Bachelor of Music, Performance

- Two grade one compositions in contrasting styles or one grade one multi-movement work from the Texas UIL PML.
- Major and minor scales
- Chromatic scale
- Sight reading

Brass

Bachelor of Arts and Music Minor

- One composition from the Texas UIL PML, any grade, or the All-Region audition material
- Major scales
- Chromatic scale
- Sight reading

Bachelor of Music, Teacher Certification

- Two contrasting compositions from the Texas UIL PML, one from any grade, one from grade two or higher, or one solo grade two or higher and one All-Region etude of contrasting styles.
- Major scales
- Chromatic scale
- Sight reading

Bachelor of Music, Performance

- Two grade one compositions in contrasting styles or one grade one multi-movement work from the Texas UIL PML.
- Major and minor scales
- Chromatic scale
- Sight reading

Percussion

Bachelor of Arts and Music Minor

- One composition each for snare drum, timpani, and keyboard, any grade, from the Texas UIL PML.
- Drum set is optional, but encouraged.
- Major scales on keyboard, one octave, tempo of J = 90 beats per minute played in eighth-notes
- Sight reading on snare drum.

Bachelor of Music, Teacher Certification

- One composition each for snare drum, timpani, and keyboard, grade two or higher, from the Texas UIL PML.
- Drum set is strongly encouraged, but optional.
- Major scales on keyboard, two octaves, J = 90 beats per minute played in eighth-notes
- Sight reading on snare drum and keyboard.

Bachelor of Music, Performance

- One composition each for snare drum, timpani, and keyboard, grade one, from the Texas UIL PML.
- Drum set, required, demonstrate a basic rock, Latin (e.g. bossa nova, samba, cascara, etc.), and swing feel.
- Major scales on keyboard, two octaves, J = 104 beats per minute played in eighth-notes
- Sight reading on snare drum, keyboard, and timpani.
