Apply for dual credit admissions through ASU

- Go to angelo.edu/dualcredit
- Select "Apply Now" button
- Complete and submit the online dual credit application

Be certain to <u>submit</u> the application at the end. **The student's name used when applying should match the name on the high school transcript.**

Submit a Dual Credit Agreement Form

A signed dual credit agreement form must be submitted to ASU. Your parent/guardian will receive an email to submit this electronically a few days after the online application is submitted. This will be sent to the parent email entered on the dual credit application.

- The electronic agreement form is the preferred method to submit this. However, a paper agreement form can be printed, signed and returned to your high school.

Submit Test Scores for TSI

Request your high school to send your test scores, if required based on the classes taking. Test scores are required for students taking a **Math or English class**. See the TSI Eligibility chart below for acceptable test scores to meet this requirement.
