

Angelo State Dual Credit Enrollment Checklist

1 Apply for dual credit admissions through ASU

- Go to angelo.edu/dualcredit
- Select “Apply Now” button
- Complete and submit the online dual credit application

Be certain to submit the application at the end. **The student’s name used when applying should match the name on the high school transcript.**

2 Submit a Dual Credit Agreement Form

A signed dual credit agreement form must be submitted to ASU. Your parent/guardian will receive an email to submit this electronically a few days after the online application is submitted. This will be sent to the parent email entered on the dual credit application.


- The electronic agreement form is the preferred method to submit this. However, a paper agreement form can be printed, signed and returned to your high school.

3 Submit Transcripts via TRES

Please request a transcript to be sent via TRES.

4 Submit Test Scores for TSI

Request your high school to send your test scores, if required based on the classes taking. Test scores are required for students taking a **Math or English class**. See the TSI Eligibility chart below for acceptable test scores to meet this requirement.
