

DUAL CREDIT ENROLLMENT CHECKLIST

1. Discuss course options with your school.

Check with your high school counselor for available courses and enrollment requirements.

2. Apply for dual credit admission at angelo.edu/dual-credit.

3. Submit a Dual Credit Agreement Form.

Your parent/guardian will receive an email to submit this electronically a few days after you apply. This will be sent to the parent email address entered on the dual credit application.

For those unable to submit the electronic agreement form, a paper agreement can be found online to be printed, signed and returned to your high school.

4. Request transcripts to be sent.

5. Watch the dual credit orientation video.

The orientation video will provide you with important information about ASU dual credit. The video can be found at angelo.edu/dual-credit/student-resources.

6. Be responsible.

Once you begin dual credit classes, keep up with important deadlines and know the resources available to you.
