Transfer Credit from Military Language Programs

A. Scores from the Defense Language Proficiency Test (DLPT)

Angelo State University accepts credit based on the DLPT (Defense Language Proficiency Test), using the ACE recommended scores, up to a total of 21 credit hours. The credit is awarded as both upper and lower division language credit exactly as it appears on the report. **DLPT Reading, Listening, DLPT OPI (Oral Proficiency Interview)**. See Addendum 1 for transfer details.

B. Transcripts from the Defense Language Institute

Credit can also be awarded based on transcripts from the Defense Language Institute in Monterey, California. These transcripts are individually evaluated by the Angelo State Department of English and Modern Languages. Most of the transcripts come from the “Basic 01” course, which awards 12 hours of lower-division credit, and 12 hours of upper-division language credit. Additional upper-division elective credit may be awarded for other upper-division DLI courses that do not transfer in for BA major requirements. The maximum number of total credit hours transferred from the Defense Language Institute for one language is 33. If the DLPT exam would award more credits than the transcript, students may use the DLPT score report for credit basis. Under no circumstances should credit be awarded for both the transcript and exam.

C. Transcripts from the National Cryptologic School

Angelo State University accepts transfer credit for foreign language courses from the National Cryptologic School based on the ACE credit recommendation for lower-division and upper-division baccalaureate category and number of credit hours. Students are encouraged to contact their advisors for possible inclusion of the transferred courses in the language majors and minors. Additional upper-division elective credit may be awarded for other upper-division NCS courses that do not transfer in for BA major requirements. The maximum number of total credit hours transferred from NCS for one language is 33. See Addendum 2 for transfer details.

*Angelo State University requires 36 upper-division credits, of which 24 come from the Spanish major requirements as set forth above (whether awarded transfer credit or taken through ASU). Any upper-level National Cryptologic School ACE recommended SPAN or Defense Language Institute course may be accepted for ASU upper-division elective credit to count toward the total 36 advanced hours. Students must ensure, however, that they complete at least 24 advanced credit hours and a total of 30 credit hours through Angelo State University.

**Transferable hours vary by student. Course credit awarded will be determined after all transcripts and test scores have been received.
